



Camp Tippy Canoe

Every student who has participated in a "Partners For Youth" group at their school is eligible to attend our summer camp program. Past campers are also able to return to camp for another session. We may also select other youth we feel could benefit from a week at camp.

Camp Tippy Canoe is located on 110 Acres of wilderness on Route 122, in North Lake, New Brunswick.

During your session at camp you will...

- Meet new friends
- Swim
- Learn about the environment
- Probably get a few bug bites
- Sleep in tents
- Help plan and participate in a canoe trip
- Eat great food
- We also have a low ropes course

Each week there will be two groups of campers . Each group will consist of 10 campers and 4 staff, this allows the campers to be well cared for at all times! Our camp staff are all university / college students or have already completed their education. Many of our staff are returning for a third year with Partners For Youth.

Partners For Youth will pick up and drop off the campers at a central location in your area. You will be notified of the pick up and drop off locations, and what to bring to camp when your camp spot is confirmed. NOTE: all high school and elementary camps will pick up and drop off in Fredericton.

Please fill out **BOTH SIDES** of the attached registration form and mail it to the address on the top of the form. Make sure the entire form is filled out, forms that are not complete will be returned to you without your spot being held. Do not send the form to your school as they often don't make it to our office in time and you may miss the opportunity to attend camp. This year we are sending out over 500 registration forms. We only have 170 camp spots available. Please return your form as soon as possible. Our camps will often be full by the first week of May. If your camp is full, we will put your name on our waiting list.

Please pay close attention to the week for your area. If you are not able to attend the week designated for your area, you may choose another week but you will be responsible for arranging transportation to the designated pickup spot for that week. Please contact us if you need more information.

Does it cost anything? No. Your week at camp is funded by the generosity of many organizations.
